Dance Tip's

Many of today's country Songs work better with the Shuffle than the traditional Two-Step. Some songs require a faster pace. The trick to keeping up with the beat is to take smaller steps.

Once you get on the dance floor you will have to adjust steps to keep up with the beat of the music.

Transfer weight smoothly and evenly from one foot to the other.

If your unsure of yourself or your partner, stick to the basics. Don't try any fancy turns until you have learned them the correct way.
