When couples dance, it is the
woman who is showcased.
Men..it is your job to make the
woman look good. It may be
tempting to show her we know
some cool moves but if she
hasn't learned t follow
them yet she can't do them
well.

Then she doesn't look good
and she may not want to
dance with you again. Men..
When you dance with
a less experienced dancer or
someone new it is a
good idea to stick with the
basics.

After you dance with her
awhile and know what she
can and cannot do, you can
then introduce a more
advanced move.

If it works..GREAT! If
not.....go back to the basics.
Remember, the dance is all
about the woman and it's our
job to make them look good.
